The novel is based on the last days and the assassination of one of the most tyrannical and bloodthirsty dictators of Latin American, Rafael Leonidas Trujillo. The author recounts the story of Urania Cabral, a woman who fled from Trujillo's regime in Santo Domingo as a young child and returns to confront a terrifying past. A passionate story combining anger and bewilderment. It is almost unthinkable to accept the brutal happenings as real; it is easier to believe that they were only possible in the mind of the author.

A lo largo de la obra, éste hace uso estratégico de la intriga y de las escenas picantes, para hacer la lectura más amena e interesante; y en mi opinión, el uso de estos recursos es más que un sutil guiño a la literatura pop, del más puro estilo Dan Brown. Mientras leía, imaginaba y comparaba lo que debía pasar por la mente de gobernantes y políticos de países más desarrollados, al tiempo que el Chivo únicamente pensaba en estrategias perversas para exterminar a sus enemigos y conservar el poder. Rafael Leonidas Trujillo Molina jamás pensó en los avances científicos de su tiempo (1961), ni en los cambios sociales que estaban ocurriendo en otros lugares fuera de América Latina. Pese a tener el poder absoluto, jamás se dió tiempo de pensar en el futuro de su país, ni le preocupó construir un modelo de sociedad más justa y equitativa. En ese sentido, era un completo imbécil; y sin embargo, al mismo tiempo era un excelente líder político. De hecho, ninguno de los personajes de la novela jamás tomó en cuenta lo que pasaba fuera de las fronteras de República Dominicana, salvo para comparar las rebeliones y golpes de estado de otras naciones latinoamericanas. Esta situación, que se repite al día de hoy, me descompone. Especial mención merece Ramfis, el hijo mayor de Trujillo, playboy de alto vuelo para la alta y baja sociedad; y al mismo tiempo violador, asesino desvergonzado y degenerado del más alto calibre. Me encanta cómo Vargas-Llosa describe de cuerpo entero este personaje, basado en los niños “bien” latinoamericanos, mostrando con exactitud sus complejos y conductas sicópaticas y antisociales. Vargas-Llosa es un maestro de la literatura. Al mismo tiempo, debe ser un zorro que jamás ha perdido un argumento; y esa destreza debe haberle costado más de una relación personal y profesional, y unos cuantos puñetazos de quienes, enfrentados a este maestro del verbo, tuvieron la razón, pero no la habilidad argumentativa del escritor.
